# APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. When was the last time you had an evangelistic conversation with a non Christian? What is keeping you from making evangelism a more consistent habit?
2. Read 1 Thess 2:1-4. What are specific things we should pray for when asking God for opportunities to share the gospel? How can we prepare ourselves to face ridicule for the sake of the gospel? Discuss some bad motives for evangelism, then discuss good motives.
3. Read 1 Thess 2:5-7. Why might we be tempted to use flattery during evangelistic opportunities? Why is it important to have a gentle demeanor during evangelism? Is it ever appropriate to be harsh when sharing the gospel?
4. Read 1 Thess 2:8-12. What does a lack of evangelism say about the love you have for non Christians? What behavior that is inconsistent with the message of the gospel do you need to repent of?
