# BOARD OF TRUSTEE MEETING SATURDAY APRIL 17, 2021 AT 8:30 A.M. CLUBHOUSE 2

**CALL TO ORDER**: The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am.

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

**MOTION**: Trustee Oreto moved to accept the March 20, 2021 Board of Trustee Meeting Minutes as presented. Seconded by Trustee Singelais. **The motion passed unanimously.** 

#### APPROVAL OF EMAIL VOTES

**MOTION**: Trustee Martel moved to approve the email votes of the pipe purchase, additional funds for the new well pump and the settlement on lot 0568. Seconded by Trustee Singelais. **The motion passed unanimously.** 

#### TREASURER'S REPORT

Trustee Fowler reported that as of the end of March, the Overall Budget was 87.32% spent, the Operating was 86.87% spent and we are 91.67% through the Fiscal Year. The Operating Account showed a balance of \$35,100 the CD Money Market Account had a balance of \$899,851 and Petty Cash showed a balance of \$300 for a total of \$935,251.

**MOTION**: Trustee Singelais moved to accept the Treasurer's Report for March 2021. Seconded by Trustee Berry. **The motion passed unanimously with Trustee Fowler abstaining.** 

### DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

Amy Harris reported:

- Water Shut Off Notices: We sent out 60 notices for March and did not shut off anyone. In April, this would be people that had the May payment deferred, we sent out 26 notices.
- Bank Collections: We collected \$2,722 and will have to write off \$709.67 for lot 2189.

**MOTION**: Trustee Martel moved to write off \$709.67 on lot #2189. Seconded by Trustee Fowler. **The motion passed unanimously.** 

- **COVID Outbreak**: We have a COVID outbreak among the crew. A State epidemiologist discussed the situation with us and has been very helpful. Since we provide essential services, the crew can continue to work while quarantining at home.
- Chicken Letter: A member on Old Country Way has chickens. We sent the standard letter.
- **Lightning Strike**: Slowly working on getting everything back to normal; waiting for some computer parts.
- Tree Cutting in Wildlife Reserve: Deputy Sanborn advised us that a New Dam Road resident was cutting trees in the wildlife reserve. There is also a member on Beaver Dam Road cutting trees. Board advised us to send a letter to stop. Board wants a policy drafted for a flat \$500 fine for cutting trees on the common properties.

## **Lake Improvement Committee**

Trustee Fitzpatrick reported that the DEP recognized the extra invasive species and awarded more money in both grants and CBI program.

# **Recreation Committee**

Trustee Singelais reported the yoga class is expected to start April 26 following COVID protocols.

Trustee Exley reported members have paperwork on closings for the lots. Some are using title companies, some are not. They are scheduled to happen in May.
