SOL HIRSCH GRANT

DESCRIPTION

Up to four (4) Grants, **worth \$750 each**, are available from the NWA Foundation to help improve the education of K-12 students in meteorology and related sciences.

These grants are possible thanks to the many NWA members and family and friends of Sol Hirsch who retired in 1992 after being the NWA Executive Director for 11 years. Sol passed away in October 2014.

REQUIREMENTS

Teachers, program directors, school district supervisors and other individuals or groups proposing to **improve the education of K-12 students** in meteorology may submit an application. The school or organization must be a publicly recognized and/or accredited in the United States.

The application is completed **online** and consists of information related to the individual(s) submitting and a proposal regarding the initiative. The proposal should be **a thorough description of activities, costs and expected outcomes** of the initiative. Applications should include details and specific cost estimates of how the money (\$750) will be spent.

SPRING SCHOLARSHIPS

DAVID SANKEY MINORITY SCHOLARSHIP

An award of up to \$1,000 to aid minority students in their sophomore year or higher of undergraduate study, or in graduate study.

DR. RODERICK A. SCOFIELD SCHOLARSHIP

An award of up to \$1,000 to aid aspiring meteorologists in their final two years of undergraduate study or in graduate study.

KEN REEVES MEMORIAL ACCUWEATHER UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

An award of up to \$1,000 to aid students in their sophomore year or higher of undergraduate study, enrolled in a program of meteorology or atmospheric science (or related field).

BROADCAST METEOROLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

An award of up to \$1,000 to aid students in their sophomore year or higher of undergraduate study, or in graduate study, who are aspiring broadcast meteorologists.

BOB GLAHN SCHOLARSHIP IN STATISTICAL METEOROLOGY

An award of up to \$2,500 to aid students in their final two years of undergraduate study, enrolled in a program of meteorology or atmospheric science with a demonstrated interest in statistical meteorology.
