

THORNBURY ROAD (1801)

Baltimore

Designed by architect John Dixon, the Stick-style Mount Washington Presbyterian Church was occupied by its congregation from 1878 until the mid 1960s. When the congregation disbanded the Guth family, which had held a mortgage on the property since the onset of the Depression, sold the structure to The Chimes, a Baltimore-based nonprofit organization that provides jobs and care to the disabled, in 1968.
