

CHARLES STREET (4700-4900 North) Academy Baltimore
east side Perline

"Sisters of Notre Dame had bought from David H. Price and Joseph Reynolds property on Charles Street avenue, 33 acres at \$500 an acre; Main part covered with heavy growth of timber. This they planned to lay out as park; and erect building 400 by 160 feet; three stories high, with basement and mansard roof; center building and two wings as college for women and preparatory school for girls; with convent church, chapel, large exhibition hall etc. Work would be begun at once by S. H. & J. F. Adams. When completed it would probably be the largest structure of the kind in the American continent."
