REVELATION 5 PT1 [61-0611]

I said, "The greatest thrill I have is living for others."

And he said, "That's what life is, makes life real, is when you... not what you can do or accomplish for yourself, but what you can do for others."

See, that's when you're really living. And if there happens to be someone among us who has never did that, tried to live for somebody else, give that a try, and just see how much more life holds for you when you will not live for what you can get yourself out of life but what you can give someone else in life. And you'll find that it's more blessed than riches or anything of... that can be thought of. Is what you can do for someone else to make life's burdens... Which, life in itself is a burden. THAT DAY ON CALVARY [60-0925]

When you say you go to church and you do good things, that's fine. But when you live your life to yourself, you haven't Eternal Life. <u>Eternal Life is living for others</u>.

THAT DAY ON CALVARY [60-0925] Someone said, "How can you stand and let anybody call you such bad names?" You don't live for yourself. You live for others that you might redeem that man. You become sons. And the trouble of it is, the church has forgot they were sons. You are sons. You're taking Christ's place. You are sons; so don't live for yourself; live for others. "Well, Brother Branham, I can live for this brother because he sure is a nice man." That's not it. Live for that man who hates you. Live for that person who'd kill you if they could. That's what they done to Him. They killed Him, and He died that He might save them. That's Eternal Life. When you get, that's in your bosom, you're facing heaven then.

GETTING IN THE SPIRIT [61-0428]

That's the kind of love that Christ had, "Father, forgive them; they don't know what they're doing." What if He'd held my sins against me? What an awful person I was, but He loved me so well that He forgave me for them. When I was undone, He forgave me. He loved me, a pure love.

THE CHURCH AND ITS CONDITION [56-0805]
